As a result of the event, participants are expected to:

- Enhance their understanding of the requirements of ISO17025 for environmental radioactivity laboratories
- Understand how they can work in-line with ISO17025 requirements and develop the required processes and procedures.

# **Participation**

• The event is open to **any candidates from the designated counterparts of** the TC regional project RER7014. The short virtual workshop is designed for those participating counterparts who do not have ISO17025 accreditation in their laboratories or for new staff in the counterpart organizations.

## Participants' Qualifications and Experience

Nominated candidates should be the designated counterparts of project RER7014. They are expected to be professionals from governmental technical support organizations, entities, regulatory bodies, or other institutions authorized or appointed to develop environmental monitoring strategies, and to plan and implement environmental monitoring programmes. This includes responsibilities related to sampling, analytical measurement of radionuclides in environmental media, as well as interpretation and communication of monitoring data in relation to planned, existing, or emergency exposure situations.

The regional event will be conducted in English. Therefore, candidates must have sufficient proficiency in English to actively participate in the planned activities.

This activity is conducted by the IAEA, with funding by the European Union.
